The Chairman called the meeting to order at 8:09 P.M.

The minutes of February 9, 1976 were approved as corrected.

The minutes of the Public Hearing held February 28, 1976, were approved as amended.

The Chairman regretfully announced the resignation of Malcolm Arbuthnot.

Mr. Lucke and Mr. Stophen again brought the question of their subdivision before the Commission. It was the consensus of the Commission that the front lots should be two acres and the back lots could then be one acre thereby providing a terracing effect.

The Commission advised Mr. Mizock to take his plat for subdivision to the Village Trustees as it appears to comply with the subdivision ordinance.

The matter of the proposed development on the North West corner of the intersection of Barrington Road and Route 68 (Dundee Road) was raised for consideration by the Commission. After a discussion of the matter, it was voted unanamously, with Mr. Alberts abstaining, that the Village Trustees be advised that the Commission is firmly of the opinion that the proposed development is contrary to the plan of the Village of Barrington Hills and inimical to the orderly development of the Village and distructive of the objectives adopted by the Commission and that for these reasons the Village Trustees be requested to adopt a resolution opposing such a development and taking other appropriate action to that end.
