MEETING OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES Barrington Hills April 27, 1959

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills was held at 8 PM on Monday evening, April 27th, 1959, at the Countryside School, Brinker and County Line Roads, Barrington Hills, Illinois. Mr. Dallstream, village president, was present and presided at the meeting. He directed the Clerk to call the roll. The following Trustees were present: Mrs. Bard, Mr. Caesar, Mr. Grace and Mr. Stresen-Reuter. Mr. Canby, village attorney, Mr. Hartmann, treasurer, and Mr. Harold Olson, superintendent of Public Works were also present; Mr. Raymond J. Grigsby and Mr. Delmar Olson, Trustees-elect, also attended the meeting.

The President asked the Clerk to read the minutes of the meeting of April 21st. The minutes were approved as read.

Mr. Dallstream announced that it would be advisable to try to close up the years work of the Board of Trustees. He recommended that the number of members on the Plan Commission be increased by five more members because of the increasing importance of this Commission. Thereupon, Mr. Caesar moved and Mr. Grace seconded the adoption of the following Resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills that Paragraph 38 of Section II of the Village Code be amended to read as follows: "Members and Terms. The Plan Commission shall consist of the Village President and a member of the Board of Appeals, under the Zoning Ordinance

of the Village, who shall serve until the expiration of their respective terms as such officers, and <u>eleven</u> other members, each of whom shall serve for a term of three years. All members of said commission shall be appointed by the President with the approval of the Board of Trustees."

Mr. Dallstream directed the Clerk to call the roll. The vote was as follows:
