You are hereby commanded to levy and collect from the several persons named in the Roll or Book hereto annexed, and herewith committed to you (the same being the tax assessment upon the property in said Town for the current year, and for former years, as therein shown), the several sums of money entered in the column of "Totals" of said Roll or Book, opposite their respective names. You will proceed to collect the taxes and assessments mentioned in said Book, and for that purpose you will call at least once upon each person taxed, named in said Book, or at his place of business (if he resides in said Town), and make demand for the taxes and assessments charged to him upon his property. And in case any person named in this Book shall neglect or refuse to pay his, her or their personal property tax imposed upon him when demanded, you shall levy the same, together with the costs and charges that may accrue, by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of such person. In case any person against whom the tax is assessed has removed from said town to another town in said County without paying said tax, you will levy and collect such tax of the goods and chattels of such person, in any town within said County to which said person shall have removed, or from property from such person wherever the same may be found in said County. In levying on and selling personal property for taxes, you will be governed by the same rules and be entitled to the same fees as Constables are, or may be, for like services or executions; but in no case will you charge mileage unless you are compelled to distrain property; and in case of such levy of goods and chattels by you, you will give public notice of the time and place of sale, and of the property to be sold, with the name of the delinquent, at least five days previous to the day of sale, by advertisements in writing, to be posted up in at least three public places in said town, where such sale is to be made; and at such time and place you will, if the same shall not be redeemed by payment of the taxes, sell the same at public auction, and if practicable no more property shall be sold than sufficient to pay the taxes, costs and charges due. If the property thus distrained shall be sold for more than the amount of taxes and charges due, you will return the surplus to the person in whose possession such property was when distress was made, if no claim shall be made to such surplus by any other person. If any other person shall claim such surplus on the ground that the property sold belonged to him, and such claim be admitted by the person for whose tax the same was distrained, you will pay such surplus to such owner. Out of the moneys collected by you by virtue hereof, after deducting the compensation to which you are legally entitled, you will pay over as follows, to-wit: To the proper officers the amount of tax collected for the support of highways and bridges; and to the Supervisor of the town, the moneys which will have been collected therein to defray town expenses; to the proper school officers, the district school tax, and to the County Collector, the County tax and the taxes payable to the State Treasury collected by you, at the time and in the manner directed by law; and to the City or incorporated Town or Village Treasurer, or other proper officer, the taxes or special assessments collected by you for such City, incorporated Town or Village, or others, as often, and at such times as may be demanded by the proper officers. All of which payments herein specified you are required to make on or before the tenth day of March next. Hereof fail not to make returns of your doings, by virtue hereof, under the penalties of the law in such cases made and provided.
