

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD  
OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKE BARRINGTON, ILLINOIS

January 2, 1979

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lake Barrington was held on Tuesday, January 2, 1979 at 8 p. m. in the Lake Barrington Village Hall, Kelsey Road, Barrington, Illinois as provided for by ordinance. On roll call, the following answered:

Also present: Attorney Springer and Ray Donini

A motion was made by Trustee Rebmann and seconded by Trustee Spicer to appoint Trustee Tucker President Pro Tem in the temporary absence from the Village of President Wood. On roll call, the vote was:

The motion carried.

A motion was made by Trustee Spicer and seconded by Trustee Krueger to approve the minutes of the December 28, 1978 special meeting as distributed. On roll call, the vote was:

Nays: None  
The motion carried.

A motion was made by Trustee Krueger and seconded by Trustee Spicer to accept the treasurer's report for the period ended December 31, 1978. On roll call, the vote was:

Yeas: Trustees Krueger, Spicer, Rebmann and Tucker  
Nays: None  
The motion carried.

The village clerk read correspondence received and presented the following bills for payment:

A motion was made by Trustee Rebmann and seconded by Trustee Spicer to pay the bills as submitted. On roll call, the vote was:

The motion carried.

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Building Commissioner Donini reported on his inspection of Mr. Hoffman's unit in Lake Barrington Shores. He stated that a second trap was necessary under a kitchen sink unit and that a shutoff valve should be installed on each unit's water supply as it comes into a unit. A shutoff valve existed but it shut off the water supply to all units. He indicated that Mr. Sayers will take care of the trap under the sink and Mr. Donini plans to make another inspection.

He asked that plans for units under construction be changed in regard to the two points mentioned above.

The clerk read a report submitted by Mrs. Ethel Jacobson after attending a meeting at the county level on grid numbering within the village. After discussion, which included statements by Mr. Robert Broda, president of the Wauconda Fire District, the consensus of the board was to table grid numbering until the next meeting.

Trustee Krueger stated that since his presentation was not yet complete re building codes and inspection procedures followed by the village and since Mr. Hoffman was not present, he preferred to present his findings at the next meeting.

A motion was made by Trustee Spicer and seconded by Trustee Krueger to adjourn the meeting. The voice vote was unanimous and the meeting adjourned at 9 p. m.
