

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF  
TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKE BARRINGTON  
HELD MARCH 6, 1973

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lake Barrington was held on Tuesday, March 6, 1973, at 8 P.M. at Communication Analysis Institute, Kelsey Road, Barrington, Illinois, as provided by ordinance. On roll call the following answered:

The village clerk read the minutes of the meeting held February 6, 1973 and a motion was made by Trustee Erzberger and seconded by Trustee Schleifer to approve the minutes as read. On roll call the following answered:

The motion carried and the minutes approved as read.

Mr. Peavey gave the treasurer's report and filed it with the village clerk. A motion was made by Trustee Spicer and seconded by Trustee Gibbs to approve the treasurer's report as given. On roll call the following answered:

The motion carried and the treasurer's report approved as given.

A motion was made by Trustee Spicer and seconded by Trustee Gibbs to pay the bills as presented. On roll call the following answered:

The motion carried and the bills approved for payment.

A motion was made by Trustee Tucker and seconded by Trustee Schleifer to approve the five names for judges of election. On roll call the following answered:

The motion carried and judges of election named.

Mr. Richard Sukowski gave a presentation regarding cable TV in the village. The board said it would be interested in hearing from the members of the village regarding their interest in cable TV. Mr. Sukowski informed the board that this was not something that was to happen in the real near future.

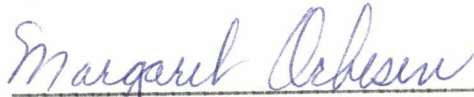
