

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE

HELD APRIL 1, 1969

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lake Barrington was held on Tuesday, April 1, 1969, at Sales Analysis Institute, Kelsey Road, Barrington, Illinois, as provided by ordinance. On roll call the following answered:

A motion was made by Trustee Tucker and seconded by Trustee Nelson to approve the appointment of judges. On roll call the vote was:

The motion carried and the judges approved for appointment.

After some discussion about a radio for Ralph Topple's car a motion was made by Trustee Spicer and seconded by Trustee Nelson to authorize Ray Tucker to investigate prices for radios suitable ~~XXXXXX~~ and to purchase same. On roll call the vote was:


Yeas: Trustees Spicer, Nelson, Tucker and Schleifer
