TYPE, DATE AND PLACE OF MEETING

ORDINANCE NO. 8 - BUILDING ORDINANCE

At the direction of the President, an ordinance entitled "Building Ordinance of the Village of Lake Barrington" was presented and read by the Village Clerk. It was moved by Trustee Wienecke, seconded by Trustee Schleifer, that the ordinance be passed as presented as Ordinance No. 8. After stating the motion, and after discussion, the President called for a vote, and on roll call, the vote was:
