

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF
THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF LAKE BARRINGTON HELD
OCTOBER 5, 1965

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lake Barrington was held Tuesday, October 5, 1965, at Sales Analysis Institute, Kelsey Road, as provided by ordinance. The meeting was called to order at 8:10 P.M. and on roll call the following answered:

The Village Clerk read the minutes of the meeting of September 7, 1965, and a motion was made by Trustee Nelson and seconded by Trustee Schleifer to accept the minutes as read. On roll call the vote was:

The motion carried and the minutes approved.

Trustee Bartlett arrived at 8:25 P.M.

The Village Clerk presented a bill from Louis Landau in the amount of \$67.00 to cover building inspections and issuing of permits to date. A motion was made by Trustee Weinecke and seconded by Trustee Schleifer to pay the bill as presented. On roll call the vote was:

The motion carried and the bill approved for payment.

A motion was made by Trustee Tucker and seconded by Trustee Nelson to adopt Resolution Establishing Prevailing Wages. On roll call the vote was:

The motion carried and Resolution # 65-R-4 passed.

The motion carried and the petition denied.

A motion was made by Trustee Bartlett and seconded by Trustee Nelson to adjourn the meeting. On roll call the vote was:

RESOLUTION NO. 4 - 65-R-4

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PREVAILING WAGES

(CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE)

WHEREAS, Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 48, 39s-1, 39s, 12, Prevailing Wage Law, as amended August 8, 1961, requires that the public body awarding any contract for public work or doing the work by day labor shall ascertain the general prevailing hourly rate of wages for employees engaged in such work, except as altered by the Supreme Court Decision in the City of Monmouth vs Lorenz, and

WHEREAS, the Statutes further provide that said rates of pay be publicly posted and/or kept available for inspection by any interested party and a certified copy thereof promptly filed in the office of the Secretary of State.

THEREFORE, BE IN RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lake Barrington, Lake County, State of Illinois, that the determination of the prevailing wages as set forth below are the prevailing hourly rates being paid to all laborers, workmen and mechanics engaged in the construction of streets or public buildings coming under the jurisdiction of this Board of Trustees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply to the prevailing hourly rate of wages in the locality for employment other than public works construction as defined in the Act, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village Clerk be and he is hereby authorized to file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Secretary of State.
