

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR ADJOURNED

OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKE BARRINGTON
HELD ON JUNE 20, 1967

The Village Clerk read the minutes of the May 2, 1967, meeting and a motion was made by Trustee Nelson and seconded by Trustee Meiners to approve the minutes as read. On roll call the vote was:

The Village Clerk was instructed to mail a Liquor License to the Knights of Columbus Club.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aforesaid Bond #3206056 be returned to the Northern Illinois Gas Company, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the acceptance of Bond # 684055-214 is conditioned upon presentation to the corporate authorities within 10 days after each anniversary date thereof of a certificate showing annual premium for said bond has been paid and said bond is in full force and effect, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be send to the Northern Illinois Gas Company along with the superseded bond. On roll call the vote was:
