

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE
BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF
LAKE BARRINGTON HELD SEPTEMBER 3, 1974

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lake Barrington was held on Tuesday, September 3, 1974, at Lake Barrington Park District Building, Kelsey Road, Barrington, Illinois, as provided by ordinance. On roll call the following answered:

The village clerk read the minutes of the meeting held August 6, 1974, and a motion was made by Trustee O'Connor and seconded by Trustee Erzberger to approve the minutes as read. On roll call the vote was:

and Krueger

The motion carried and the minutes approved as read.

Mr. Roy Peavey gave the treasurer's report and filed it with the village clerk. A motion was made by Trustee O'Connor and seconded by Trustee Krueger to approve the treasurer's report as given. On roll call the vote was:

the motion carried and the treasurer's report approved as given.'

The village clerk presented bills from the following: Lake Barrington Park District, \$539.45; Robert Freking, \$40.00; Cuba Township, \$285.00. A motion was made by Trustee Erzberger and seconded by Trustee O'Connor to pay the bills as presented. On roll call the vote was:

The motion carried and the bills approved for payment.

The village clerk read a Proclamation from Grace Mary Stern requesting a night set aside for voter registration in the village. A motion was made by Trustee Krueger and seconded by Trustee Spicer to pass the Proclamation and set October 1, 1974, the designated night. On roll call the vote was:

The motion carried and the Proclamation passed.

Trustee Tucker informed the Board he had a price of \$3,300.00 to repair the bad section on Old Barrington Road. A motion was made by Trustee Krueger and seconded by Trustee Leyhane to authorize Tucker to fix the road. On roll call the vote was:

The motion carried.

President Hubschman will invite the Lake County Sheriff to address our board November 5, 1974.

Mr. Foster addressed the Board regarding an open ditch and mounds of dirt that inhibit cutting of grass on his property along Pepper Road. A motion was made by Trustee Leyhane and seconded by Trustee Erzberger to have President Hubschman get an estimate of putting in drain tile along the road and filling in the ditch. If Mr. Foster is willing to install the pipe the village is willing to pay one half the expense of the pipe. On roll call the vote was:
