The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lake Barrington was held on Tuesday, November 5, 1974, at Lake Barrington Park District Building, Kelsey Road, Barrington, Illinois, as provided by ordinance. On roll call the following answered:

The village clerk read the minutes of the meeting held October 1, 1974, and a motion was made by Trustee O'Connor and seconded by Trustee Erzberger to approve the minutes as read. On roll call the vote was:

The motion carried and the minutes approved as read.

The village treasurer, Roy Peavey, gave the treasurer's report and filed it with the village clerk. A motion was made by Trustee Erzberger and seconded by Trustee Spicer to approve the treasurer's report as given. On roll call the vote was:

The motion carried and the treasurer's report approved as given.

The village clerk presented the Board with bills from the following: Robert Freking, \$40.00, Forrest Press, \$31.50, NIPC, \$50.00, E.M.Melahn Const. Co., \$12,640.89, Lake Barrington Park District, \$158.35, Louie Landau, \$155.00, Joe M. Pesz, \$80.00, Island Lake Service Center, \$500.00.

A motion was made by T rustee Spicer and seconded by Trustee Erzberger to accept the Island Lake Service Center snow plowing contract for Village roads this winter, with a \$500.00 retainer to be paid now. On roll call the vote was:

The motion carried and the agreement signed.

A motion was made by T rustee Leyhane and seconded by Trustee Spicer to approve the bills for payment. On roll call the vote was:

The motion carried and the bills approved for payment.

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Mr. Ed James approached the Board with the proposed TV antenna for Lake Barrington Shores. After some discussion it was decided that probably the final location should be in a commercial area on the property.

Trustee Leyhane addressed the Board regarding the Flood Plain Ordinance. After much discussion it was decided to have Wight Con= sulting Engineers address the Board next month to answer any questions the Board might have. A motion was made by Trustee Spicer and seconded by Trustee Leyhane to have some one from Wight Engineers address the December meeting. On roll call the vote was:

Trustee Leyhane is to contact NIPC rega-rding their intention to spend \$31,000.00 for an open land use survey analysis.
