One man was killed, three were possibly fatally injured and an engine and freight cars were demolished in a wreck on the Union, Joliet & Elgin railway at Ottawa about 10 miles northwest of here, early yesterday morning.

Albert Johnson, the engineer, of Joliet, is dead. Richard Steele, section leader, was taken to a Waukegan hospital, where he is likely to die. William Eckles, brakeman, was also killed and several other men were injured. The train was unloading, received signals and was taken to Joliet.
