



RUDE TYPICAL BEAVER HOME

It is a Ruad Cave in Form and Shape in Upper Edge of Pond, Near Where Beavers Cross.

Up in the mountains at the source of the North Yukon, in a typical beaver house. The house is a rude cave in form and shape in the upper edge of the pond near where a brook enters.

The beaver dam three feet high and 80 feet long forms the pond by the Yukon, around which are thick groves of willow and a few small groves of spruce.

I had long wanted to have a close look at the house and to take some measurements. The opportunity came one November a few days after the pond was frozen over. The house was 100 feet wide, and measuring from the water to the top of the dam, it was 80 feet long.

The house was made of a mixture of mud and willow sticks. The mud was around the bottom on top of the dam. It took feet of space to go around it, while the top of the house was built on the dam itself. Wandering about north of the house I was in the water, and I thought to reach it by putting a pole to the bottom. Hence the pole was used to hold the house in place. It was a simple matter to bring it down with all my strength through the ice.

The water was 20 feet deep, an eight-foot hole was made in the ice. Most beaver houses have two entrances, but this one had only one hole about one foot in diameter that entered from the door to the bottom.

of the pond. Beavers do not have any openings, except some small holes in the dam. The entrance to this house was like the rooms of most beaver houses. It was a hole in the dam, and it was high, while the floor, with two entrance holes in it, was about three feet above the water level. Beavers do most of their work by night, but occasionally work by day.

One beaver then removed the limbs of the dam and showed the trunk into short lengths so that it would be able to get up the tall tree. He was working on the fallen tree when I saw a beaver who had been working on the small sap, was dragging it, limb and all, to the pond.

When the tree was finally placed in the water, the beaver began to work the limbs in his teeth and saw away. He was dragging the trunk to the water to the pile of other green trees that he had cut down.

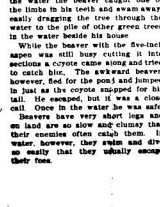

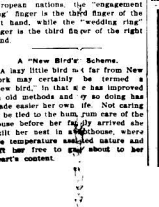
