Rep. Wins in New York.

New York elected John A. Dix Democratic candidate for governor, and Harry E. Hull, a Democrat, for Lt. Gov. Theodore Roosevelt, by about 65,000. Olof Read, Gov. Judson Harmon, was beaten by 40,000 and 60,000 votes. Two years ago Harmon was elected by 18,000.

New Jersey introduced Woodrow Wilson, former president of Princeton university, by electing him to the governorship. He beat his opponent, Alvin E. Bevill, a Democrat, by 10,000. Vinton M. Lewis, Republican, the previous Republican plurality was 8,000.

Massachusetts kept up the tradition of electing George N. Ross governor, and he beat his opponent, Gov. Elton S. Draper, whose plurality was 1,000. The legislature was evenly divided, however, which means that Henry Cabot Lodge will be returned to the Senate.

Salvation Wins in Connecticut.

In Connecticut, Judge J. Ernest H. Baldwin, a Democrat, was elected governor over Charles A. Goodwin, Republican, by 4,000 plurality. The legislature was evenly divided, but the result was 16,000.
