

# Barrington Bears Keep Slate Clean in District Baseball Tournament

## Defeat Stag Bears 3 to 1 Monday for Second Title Win

### Pitted Against Dundee Last Night; List Begins to Narrow Down

The Barrington Bears moved into a four team deadlock for first honors in the district baseball contest being held in Elgin by dumping the highly touted Elgin Stag Bears in a close 3 to 1 game Monday evening.

Behind the pitching of R. Stieckles, the Bears crossed the platter three times on four hits, and two errors. Stieckles was wild in the first two innings, working himself into a hole in the first with two walks coupled with an error. He escaped in that stanza but was picked for the only Elgin run in the second on a pair of walks and two errors.

Settling down, he handcuffed the Stag Bears and was untouchable until the seventh when Trenton left fielder for Elgin, was safe on a high infield fly that dropped safely between the mound and first base.

The Bears came back to tie the score and take the lead in the fourth stanza on the only extra base hit of the game, a double by E. Altenburg, and two errors. A single, a stolen base and a high fly to deep right field produced Barrington's other run in the fifth inning. Box score:
