We have recently been informed by officials that it is "necessary" to infuse the national debt to \$45,000,000,000 this year, but that we needn't worry for this is not the danger point.

It's easy enough to allow excessive spending. It's a great deal harder to pay the bills as they fall due. And the American people, to whom the rapidly increasing taxes have never had a taste of what paying means. We have added and added to the debt, in order to put off the evil day when income must be made to meet outgo.

But too many years have now passed for further excuse out and waste in the name of relief.

It's time for straight talk about taxation and government spending. It's time to design the debt much longer unless we are willing to court national bankruptcy.
