Cut rubbers very fine. One teaspoon crushed add juice and pulp of one orange and one teaspoon of ground nut. One tablespoon of lemon juice and 1/4 cup sugar. Stand over night until sugar is dissolved. Roll rapidly until transparent, then add chopped nuts or walnuts. Roll up into balls and place in waxed paper. Made at once with jam.
