The daily vacation bible school will open at the Barrington public school on Monday morning, June 19, at 9 o'clock. The school is sponsored by the Barrington Ministerial Union and Rev. G. P. Killebrack of St. Paul church is coordinator.

There will be five departments—Bible, arithmetic, history, intermediate and senior. Mrs. H. O. Plager is superintendent and will be assisted by the following teachers: Miss Faye Drangel will be in charge of kindergarten, which includes children of four and five years of age to those reaching their fifth birthday by February. Ellen Mason will assist with the kindergartners.

The primary department, which includes children of five and six years of age, will be under the supervision of Mrs. H. O. Plager. Mrs. Mary Ann Beckelman will be committee chairman.

Mrs. Harold Aschke, assisted by Mrs. C. E. O'Connell, will be in charge of the Junior department, which includes children of the third grade and the nine-year-old children of the first grade.

Mrs. W. A. Baeffer and Mrs. Adelle Hanson will be in charge of the intermediate department. This section includes children of the fourth grade and all those who are fifteen years of age.

Mrs. F. M. P. Brewer, assisted by Mrs. H. O. Plager, will be in charge of the senior department. This section includes children of the sixth grade and all those who are sixteen years of age.

The school will be open for a period of nine days.
