DEADLY MELANCHOLIA

In a notable article appearing in the Atlantic Monthly, Wendell L. Willkie, president of the Commonwealth and Southern Corporation, states that many of our countrymen have ignored governmental objectives "that they have assumed the necessary mechanisms by which the economic system functions."

Mr. Willkie is in opposition of reform. But he realizes that "the problem before us is how to achieve enlightened conditions without impairing the industrial system that pays the wages and utilizes investment." And at present, he believes, "we are laboring under melancholia attacking its first two deadly ways."
