

**Make Soil-Depleting  
Allowance for Farms**

More money is being given Coolidge National A. A. commission this year in determining total federal aid in soil-depleting allowances from the county allotment account.

Mr. Henry D. Dewecke, member of county committee, said that total soil-depleting allowances for county farms are now \$1,000,000, he said, and explained that the state soil-depleting allowance is about the same as last year.

The individual allotments are drawn from the average of farm acreage in the county. The additional money given comes from the state in setting the allotments for the 1940 program will allow for more adjustments. It is expected.

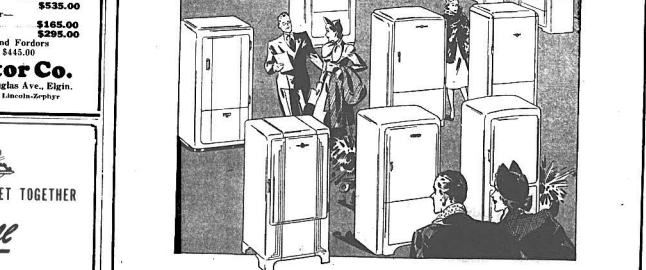
