IMRF – Trustee Smithe asked about the Treasurers letter to the Board. Robert Kosin commented on the projected employer contribution in the budget work in October of 2009.

ROADS AND BRIDGES – Elaine M. Ramesh

Monthly Report – Trustee Ramesh reported the budget for 2009 road work is within \$500,000. Our Village Engineers current estimate is at \$540,000. Open bidding for road work will be on April 28, 2009 and will be ready for the May Board meeting. Roads scheduled for work are Rock Ridge, Wagon Wheel, Surrey Lane and Surrey Court. Also Buckley and Hawley Woods need to be looked at due to buckling.

Trustee Smithe asked what is happening on Merri Oaks Road. There are significant holes two to three feet deep. President Abboud asked Robert Kosin to check. Kosin said it was a result of gas lines search, but will confirm.

In addition to Cuba Township's plowing costs of \$24,000.00, Plote's February charges for plowing and salting the Village Hall facility was \$1,400.00 and Aspen charged approximately \$1,500.00 for shoveling and salting sidewalks around the Village Hall and Fire Station.

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President Abboud requested a meeting with Trustee Ramesh, Robert Kosin and Gewalt Hamilton to discuss road repairs – batch process vs. train process. Trustee Ramesh reported a meeting is set for 9:30 a.m. on April 17th at the Village Hall.

A meeting took place with Canadian National on March 16th. Three representatives from Canadian National were at this meeting along with President Abboud, Robert Kosin, Trustee Ramesh and Village Engineer, Dan Strahan. President Abboud want to use CN's engineers to help on issues such as sound walls, berms, etc. CN is bring in coal trains going north, stopping and standing for long periods. Noise is a concern.

<u>Temporary Road Weight Restriction Resolution</u> – Trustee Ramesh motioned to accept the Road Weight Restriction. Trustee Smithe seconded. All said aye.

Comments were received from residents of Deepwood and the Polo Club. Also discussed was the adoption of a special use classification for Animal Shelters.
