ROADS & BRIDGES – Elaine M. Ramesh

<u>Monthly Report</u> – Trustee Ramesh reported that the Roads and Bridges monthly report is included in the Trustee's packets.

Trustee Ramesh reported that she and Chief Murphy, Robert Kosin, Robert Abboud, Dan Strahan and Robert Hamilton met with IDOT to discuss lowering the speed limit on Route 62. IDOT has agreed to do a speed study, but does not share the Village's interest in reducing the limit. Trustee Ramesh complimented Chief Murphy, saying he was a vociferous advocate with IDOT, suggesting they "reduce the speed limit," and provide a police turn-off and pull-off for police officers. Additionally, they discussed signage for Countryside School and learned that by State statute no flashing signals should exist there, given that children do not walk to school but are bussed. Trustee Smithe asked President Abboud to contact the principal of Countryside school to discuss this issue.

IDOT will review the proposed pedestrian crossing at Lake Cook and Oakdene. They will look at the alignment of road and sidewalk and the speed in that area.

Trustee Ramesh recommended that such a meeting with IDOT be an annual visit for the Village.

PUBLIC SAFETY - Fritz H. Gohl

Trustee Gohl reported that DUI arrests were zero in November, 2010, compared to six in 2009.

BUILDING AND ZONING – Joseph S. Messer

<u>Monthly Report</u> - Trustee Messer reported the January year-end building permit report is included in the Trustee's packets.

<u>Storm Water Ordinance</u> - Trustee Messer presented the proposed Storm Water Ordinance. Discussion followed with President Abboud questioning the level of review the Ordinance had received. After determining that the Ordinance had been seen by the Plan Commission, but not analyzed, Trustee Smithe motioned that the Storm Water Ordinance be reviewed by the Plan Commission, the ZBA, the Legal Committee, the Equestrian Commission, and the Board of Health. Trustee Ramesh seconded the motion. All present said Aye; Trustee Gohl voted Nay.
