PUBLIC SAFETY - Brian J. McManus

Monthly Report- Trustee McManus deferred to Edgar Fair, Police Chief, to summarize the Police Report for the month of December, 1997.

<u>Target Shooting Permit</u> - Trustee McManus reported that both the Village Attorney and the Police Attorney had reviewed the application for a target shooting permit, noting that the permit is valid for one year. He recommended that the permit fee be revised to recover its administrative cost and requested that the Village Attorney prepare a resolution to be considered by the Board at the next meeting.

<u>Communications Consulting Firm</u> - Trustee McManus reported that the police communications system had been reviewed by Arthur Samuels and Associates. The projected cost of replacing the system is \$60-65,000. He stated that the 9-1-1 Committee was prepared to finance \$40,000 of the expense and suggested that the General Fund provide \$25,000. The proposal will be reviewed by the Village Attorney before presentation to the Board at the February meeting.

ROAD AND BRIDGES - R. Townley Rose

<u>Hawthorne Lane</u> - President Kempe, in Trustee Rose's absence, recognized Ralph Gilbert, who summarized his requests for traffic restrictions on Hawthorne Lane and IL Route 59. Residents addressed the Board with comments. John Utz, Village Engineer answered questions. Trustees made suggestions for appropriate signage and remedies for residents' concerns at the intersection of Hawthorne Lane and IL Route 59. Trustee Horne motioned to erect intersection "T" signs on IL Route 59, both north and south of Hawthorne Lane, remove vegetation to enhance visibility north of that intersection, and install a "Cross Traffic Does Not Stop" sign at the exit from Hawthorne Lane on to IL Route 59. Trustee Fossler seconded. All present said aye.

<u>Porter School Subdivision</u> - Trustee Briggs reported that the developer had completed the installed improvements and that a letter from the Village Engineer had been received. Trustee Briggs motioned to direct the Village Attorney to prepare the necessary resolution for the release of the letter of credit for Porter School Subdivision. Trustee Fossler seconded. All present said aye.

<u>Rolling Hills Street Dedication</u> - Trustee Briggs urged the Board to make a decision, with the advise of the Village Attorney, on the street dedication by May, 1998.

BUILDING AND ZONING - Theodore L. Horne

<u>Building Reports</u> - Trustee Horne reported that 6 building permits had been issued between December 15 through December 31, 1997. These include 1 residential addition, 1 private horse barn and arena, 3 horse barn demolitions, and 1 detached garage demolition. There were 29 inspections completed, and 1 meeting was attended during this time period.

Trustee Horne reported that 1 building permit was issued between January 1 through January 15, 1998 for a single family residence. There were 30 inspections completed.

Trustee Horne distributed the End-Of-Year Report, noting that 87 building permits had been issued between January 1 through December 31, 1997.

<u>ZBA Report</u> - Trustee Horne reported that the Zoning Board had met and recommends the adoption of the 1998 Zoning Map. Trustee Horne motioned to adopt the 1998 Zoning Map with a modification to South Bateman Circle and the unnamed spur roadway which connects it to Deepwood Road. Trustee Fossler seconded.
