McHenry Co GPS Mapping - After some discussion the staff was directed to further explore our participation in the McHenry Co. geographical information system (GIS) and the Global positioning satellite program (GPS).

<u>Surface Water Drainage</u> - Trustee Briggs motioned to adopt an ordinance, as amended, to be inserted in Title 4, building code on surface water drainage regulations. Trustee McManus seconded. All said aye.

BUILDING AND ZONING - Theodore L. Horne

Zoning Map- Trustee Horne motioned to pass a resolution adopting the 1991 edition of the official zoning map of the Village of Barrington Hills. Trustee McManus seconded. All said aye.
