Street Addresses - After hearing the concerns of Mrs. Mary Fox

and Mr. Allen Radford, President Kempe stated that consideration would be given to creating a new house numbering system for Old Sutton Road.

Route 62 & 25 Construction - Trustee McManus motioned to pass a resolution, as amended, approving the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) plans for the improvement of the intersection of Illinois Routes 62 & 25. Trustee MacArthur seconded. All said aye.

No Row Encroachment on Route 25 - Trustee Horne motioned to adopt an ordinance, as amended, prohibiting encroachments within the State right of way along Illinois 25 (Elgin Road) in the area of the IDOT improvement of the intersection at Route 62 and 25. Trustee McManus seconded. All said aye.

Cedar Cove Zoning - Trustee Briggs motioned to adopt an ordinance amending the official zoning map of the Village of Barrington Hills to show the newly annexed land at 2027 North River Road, as R-4 one acre. Trustee McManus seconded. All said aye.

<u>Cedar Cove Final Plat</u> - Trustee McManus motioned to pass a resolution approving the final plat of the Cedar Cove Subdivision. Trustee Horne seconded. All said aye.

Trustee Horne seconded. All said aye.

Building Report - There were 4 building permits issued from February 16 thru March 15, 1991 as follows; 1 residential addition and alteration, 1 septic repair, 1 storage building, 1 inground swimming pool, and 1 artificial lake. There were 42 inspections and meetings.

<u>Insurance</u> - Trustee Briggs stated that she expects to have for the Board's review several insurance proposals for fiscal year 1991-92.

<u>Solid Waste Management</u> - Cook County, together with the Northeastern Illinois Plan Commission, (N.I.P.C.), is establishing a Solid Waste Management Plan.
