## ROAD AND BRIDGES - R. Townley Rose

1998 <u>Budget</u> - Trustee Sweet presented an amended budget for fiscal year 1997-98 noting changes. Trustee Sweet motioned for its approval as amended. Trustee Rose seconded. All said aye.

Trustee McManus requested staff to arrange a Personnel Committee Meeting to review salary requests in February 1998, prior to the presentation of the 1998-99 budget proposal.

<u>Appropriations Transfer Ordinance</u> - Trustee Sweet presented the proposed transfers to the 1996-97 Appropriations Ordinance. Trustee Sweet motioned to approve the Transfer Ordinance. Trustee Rose seconded. All said aye.

# Ordinance 97-5

<u>Developmental Land Use Fees</u> - Trustee Sweet presented information on Developmental Land Use Fees, which would be imposed at the time of construction of a new residence, with a specific purpose of funding road improvement projects. Members of the Board discussed the positive and negative aspects of imposing such a fee. President Kempe instructed the Village Attorney to research and prepare a letter of opinion for the June meeting.

<u>Building Department Fees</u> - Trustee Sweet deferred to Mr. Kosin to present a revised fee schedule for new contruction permits. Mr. Kosin stated that fees were last changed in 1993, while costs have increased annually to the point that the General Fund is subsidizing the Building Department. Trustee McManus motioned to amend Building Department permit fees in Section 4-1-6. Trustee Rose seconded. All said aye.

# Ordinance 97-6

# PLANNING - Lorraine H. Briggs

<u>Hawthorne Ridge Final Plat</u> - Trustee Briggs reported that the Plan Commission has recommended the approval of the final plat for Hawthorne Ridge Subdivision and that the Board of Health has reviewed and approved it. Trustee Briggs motioned for approval with one change under Note #8. Trustee McManus seconded. All said aye.

#### Motion Approved

<u>Woodhaven Subdivision</u> - Trustee Briggs reported that the Village Engineer advised that the improvements are completed, and motioned that the Board accept the subdivision and amend the letter of credit accordingly. Trustee Rose seconded. All said aye.

## BUILDING AND ZONING - Theodore L. Horne

<u>Building Reports</u> - Trustee Horne reported that 9 building permits have been issued between April 16 and May 15, 1997. These include 2 residential additions and alterations, 1 private horse barn, 2 septic system repairs, 1 gazebo, 1 inground swimming pool, 1 auto service station addition, and 1 85° TV tower. There were 81 inspections completed and 3 meetings attended during this time period.

Zoning Board of Appeals - Trustee Horne reported that the Zoning Board of Appeals had met and granted a lot line variance to Dejanovich and Valin, 129 brinker Road, for construction of a private stable following demolition of the existing barn.

## HEALTH, ENVIRONMENT AND INSURANCE - Lorraine H. Briggs

<u>Solid Waste Management</u> - Trustee Briggs reported that during the month of April 1997 the number of truckloads diverted from landfills was 3.5.

<u>Insurance</u> - Trustee Briggs reported that a new property appraisal is required for insurance purposes to insure at current values. She recommended that we have a new on-site appraisal inspection, because the last inspection was done in 1987. Estimated fees for the revision appraisal of the building and contents is \$1,200, with an additional \$600 for the Fire Station Building and certain internal improvements, and \$150 in out-of-pocket expenses. Trustee Briggs noted that the Fire Station appraisal will be reimbursed by the Barrington Countryside Fire Protection District and recommended that the Board approve signing the proposed contract with American Appraisal Associates for an onsite inspection and appraisal of the Village's property. Trustee McManus seconded. All said aye.

# Motion Approved

Trustee Briggs reported that a premium refund check for \$2,993 had been received from Illinois Public Risk Fund following a payroll audit for policy year ended December 15, 1996.

# ADMINISTRATION - James A. Kempe

Appointments - President Kempe announced that John Major nas declined reappointment as Chairman of the Plan Commission. He recommended the appointment of David Russo to the chairmanship for one year. Trustee Briggs motioned to approve the appointment of Mr. Russo as Chairman of the Plan Commission for a one-year term ending May 1998. Trustee Rose seconded. All said aye.

President Kempe recommended the reappointments of Walter E. Smithe III, John Palumbo, and Daniel Wolfgram to the Plan Commission. Trustee Rose motioned to approve these appointments. Trustee Horne seconded. All said aye.

President Kempe recommended the reappointment of Jack D. Train to the Zoning Board of Appeals. Trustee Sweet motioned to approve the appointment. Trustee Horne seconded. All said aye.

Committee Assignments - President Kempe distributed the Trustee Committeee Assignments for fiscal year 1997-98. Trustee Sweet motioned to approve the assignments. Trustee Rose seconded. All said aye.

<u>Litter</u> - Trustee Sweet motioned to approve litter removal for 10 miles of Village roads to be selected by the Roads and Bridges Committee, at a cost not to exceed \$3,000. Trustee Rose seconded.
