<u>Solid Waste Management</u> - Trustee Briggs reported that during the month of May 1997 the number of participating homes serviced was down over the previous month, but the volume diverted from landfills was up, with 2.9 truckloads diverted.

Employee Medical, Life, and AD&D Insurance - Trustee Briggs reported that a renewal proposal by The New England for medical, life, and AD&D insurance for employees has been presented with no increase in costs to the Village. An alternative plan, which includes a dental plan and raises the preventive care maximum, would increase costs by 2%. Trustee Briggs explained the differences in the two proposals and motioned to renew the current plan with The New England. Trustee Rose seconded. All said aye.
