Flashing School Sign There has been no response from School District 220 on the request for \$240 to cover the reprogramming of the flashing light due to their incorrect information. The Village Engineer will be directed to review the signage to see if an additional type of warning sign is necessary.

BUILDING AND ZONING - Theodore L. Horne

<u>Swanson Variance</u>— The Zoning Board of Appeals approved a variance from the lot area requirement. They also scheduled the items referred to them by the Board of Trustees for their future meetings.

<u>Building Report-</u> There were 10 building permits issued from June 16 thru July 16, 1990, as follows; 1 barn, 2 inground swimming pools, 1 detached garage, 1 underground storage tank, 1 site development, 2 septic system repairs, 1 deck and 1 gazebo. There were 89 inspections and meetings.

HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT - Lorraine H. Briggs

Recycling - Trustee Briggs reported that Browning Ferris Industries (BFI) have rescheduled the startup date of the weekly curbside recycling for Barrington Hills residents to September 1, 1990.

<u>Landfill</u> - Trustee Briggs reported to the Board that we have been asked to join the Solid Waste Agency of Lake County (SWALCO) and the Board asked her to review the information and give her recommendation to the Board at the next meeting.

<u>Stormwater Management</u> - Robert Kosin reported that the United States Geological Survey (USGS) has installed a computerized water gauge in Flint Creek and may consider installing additional

ones in Flint Creek. Also they will let us access the information from their computer network.

Lake Co. Stormwater Management - Trustee Briggs informed the Board that on July 30th Lake Co will hold an organizational meeting concerning its stormwater management program. It was the consensus of the Board that Robert Kosin should attend on behalf of the Village and consideration will be given in the future to a designee for the President for subsequent meetings as was suggested by the county.
