# MEETING OF THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD

# VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON HILLS

### September 26, 1977

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills was held at the Village Hall on September 26, 1977 at 8:00 P.M. Meeting was called to order by President Hansen. Roll call.

#### PRESENT:

Minutes of the August meeting were presented for approval. After noting corrections, a motion was made and seconded for approval. Motion carried.

#### BUILDING:

In the absence of Mr. Evans, Ann Blanchard reported the following permits issued in the month of September; 7 single family residences, 3 garages, 4 barns, 1 well, 1 pond, 2 additions, 1 porch and 1 septic repair.

Mrs. Hansen reported that the gas tank has been moved and it is now wholly within Village property.

Mrs. Hansen reported the progress of the remodeling program, noting that we hope to have the work completed by the end of October. then reviewed the decorating bids for the Board and requested that

a motion be entertained to waive taking of public bids and accepting the following: 1. The bid of Lee Perot Interiors for the wallpaper, and carpet installation in the amount of \$ 4,000. (Shipping not included)

2. The bid of Cliff Goerlitz for additional carpentry labor and material in the amount of \$ 2,500.

3. The bid of Dieter Schroeder for painting, wallpapering, including labor, (not including wallpaper) in the amount of \$ 2,148.

4. The bid for floor patching, quarry tile entry, stairway, bath; ceramic tile bath walls to 5' height, in the amount of \$ 2,500 estimated.

Mr. Kempe so moved, seconded by Mr. Klein. Roll call. 5 ayes, no nays, 1 absent. Motion carried.

#### FINANCE:

Mr. Tucker reviewed the budget and actual figures given to the Board, noting that the forecast for income has been lowered from \$ 220,103 to \$ 190,699. He pointed out that altho overall aggregate of expenditures is under budget, there were some areas, legal and public safety where spending is over budget. He has met with Chief Meyer and Mr. Mac-Arthur regarding budget planning for the remainder of the fiscal year and they have agreed to keep spending in line with the budget. Mr. Tucker moved approval of the Treasurer's report as submitted. Second by Mr. Hamill. The motion carried.

Mr. Tucker then presented the Audit report to the Board for approval. The Board reviewed it prior to the meeting. Mr. Tucker moved approval, seconded by Mr. Hamill. Motion carried.

At this time Mr. Tucker presented the unpaid bills to the Board for their approval. the total for the month came to \$39,781.97. Motion was made by Mr. Tucker, seconded by Mr.Kempe to approve payment of the bills. Mr. MacArthur questioned the engineering bills for the subdivisions. Mrs. Hansen pointed out that we have adopted a "cost of review" ordinance which provides that costs above the filing fees are to be paid by the subdivider. Roll call. 5 ayes, no nays, l absent. Bills were approved for payment.

#### PLANNING:

Mr. Hamill reported that three new subdivisions had come before the Plan Commission at it's September meeting. That of Mr. Pain, on Brinker Road and Mr. Meyer's behind the Village Hall were continued. The people were told to file their requests complete with the proper documents with the Village Clerk. The third was outside the Village, but within the mile and a half boundary of jurisdiction. That also was continued due to the lack of required information.

MERRY-OAKS MANOR: The preliminary plat of subdivision was approved by the Plan Commission, with recommendations to the Village Board that it be approved by them also. Mr. Hamill noted that the plat had been reviewed by Mr. Lenzini and Mr. Craig and was in order. He then moved approval. In the discussion that followed, questions were raised about

of widening of the shoulders at the top of hills on Ridge Road. His extimate was \$ 12,870 was to include ditching and removal of vegitation as well. Mr. Tucker moved and Mr. Haiml seconded, that the Village advertise for bids for the work as outlined by Mr. Lenzini. At this time Mr. MacArthur questioned the proposed work on Ridge Road, stating that he felt the striping and clearance of the overgrown brush at various intersections was of prime concern. He stated that it was his opinion that too much money had been spent on engineering for cutting down the hills on Ridge and expressed his disapproval of the outlined proposal. Roll call. 4 ayes, no nays, 1 abstention.

Mrs. Hansen asked Mr. Renshaw to get a pruning machine lined up to do the necessary pruning at intersections of Village Roads. She suggested the Police Department be consulted as to those sections where striping and brush removal were most important.

## PUBLIC SAFETY:

Mr. MacArthur reported 26 traffic accidents, 2 burglaries, 1 attempted burglary, 8 criminal damage to property cases, 4 thefts, 1 recovered stolen auto and 7 DWI arrests for the month of September.

## LEGISLATION:

Mr. Klein reported that Mr. Wine, insurance agent, had given him the new insurance policies, which he then turned over to Mr. Craig for review.

# ATTORNEY:

Mr. Craag reported that the Frank disconnection case is still pending. He expects the Bradford hearing to be scheduled for October or early November. The Healy-Blood and Booze suit has been transferred to Cook County as per our motion.

#### ADMINISTRATION:

Mrs. Hansen reported that the Village Hall basement has been cleaned out. She and some of the officers went through things and threw out the trash.

Hoffman Estates is in the process of redoing their comprehensive plan. Don Klein of BACOG is attending their meetings. He will keep us informed if any new changes affect our Village planning.

There is to be a 208 Water Qualitity Advisory meeting on October 8 at McHenry County Court House. Mr. MacArthur was asked to attend.

There being no further business, a motion was made and seconded to adjourn. Motion carried.
