The meeting was called to order at Countryside School at 8:10 P.M. The minutes of December 9, 1974 were approved as corrected.

The Chairman discussed H.U.D. per Mr. Schultz's letter. The Commission was advised that the problem was discussed with Klein of BACOG who stated that the best solution was through that agency and it was working on it. Village trustee Mrs. Hansen discussed housing committee of BACOG in regard to this type of housing.

The Chairman raised the question of a village plan. Klein of BACOG provided comprehensive plans for the village of Inverness and another BACOG village. Messrs. Schultz, Lockett, and Moseley were requested to make a study and report back at the next meeting.

The meeting was advised that Fred Klein is ready to go ahead on his subdivision.


The Commission was advised that Chap Peterson, who lives on Springwood Lane off of Algonquin Road, raised the question of a proposed addition onto his present home that would necessitate a zoning variation and was directed to the Zoning Board of Appeals.

Discussion of proposed 1000 unit project by Hemphill at Rt. 14 and Plum Tree Road, which is to be annexed to Fox River Grove. It was suggested that Mrs. Hansen inform the village trustees and that they seek the advice of the village attorney as to the possible alternatives.

Village trustee Mrs. Hansen brought up the proposed stable ordinance that was discussed several months ago and presented a suggested draft of ordinance drawn by the Riding Club and forwarded by Mrs. Lyons. The Chairman and Mr. Galloway volunteered to make a study of the stable ordinance.

Meeting adjourned at 9:20P.M.
