The meeting was called to order at Countryside School at 8:00p.m. The minutes of March 10, 1975 were approved as written.

Mr. Matthew Hegerich presented a proposed subdivision on Oak Knoll Road. The present sites have a frontage problem along Oak Knoll Rd. and the egress to the back lots. The lots are in compliance with our subdivision ordinance in regard to size and shape. There would be a possible problem on width of lots depending upon layout. Mr. Hegerich was referred to village attorney Sidney Craig for further information.

Mr. Nieto and gentlemen returned with a new plat of property on Ridge Road. The redrawn plat was referred to the village engineer for approval and an opinion...also referred to the village attorney for same. After the subdivision requirements have been met to again return to the plan commission.

Chairman Cassell discussed the equidae problem as it exists.

A number of suggestimes and ordinances from other communities have been submitted to the commission on horse problems.

Mr. Alberts gave his interpretations on existing ordinances. He would like to strengthen the enforcement process.

The chairman volunteered to request that the village attorney draw up a proposed ordinance pertinent to the equidae problem.

It was moved and passed that the regular meetings hereafter will be held at the new village hall.

Trustee Hansen recommended that the Barrington Hills building code should be updated and put on agenda for the May meeting. Meeting adjourned at 9:45P.M.
