RESOLUTION PROTESTING AMENDMENT OF COOK COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE

BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills that:

1. The proposed Amendment of the zoning ordinance of Cook County, Illinois to rezone the following described real estate:

The Northwest quarter of Section 19, Township 42 North, Range 10 East of the Third Principal Meridian in Cook County, Illinois, (except the West 33 feet thereof and except the Southwest quarter of said Northwest quarter also the West half of the Northeast quarter of Section 19 aforesaid

The East ½ of the Southwest ¼ of Section 18, Township 42, North, Range 10, East of the hird Principal Meridian in Cook County, Illinois (excepting from said tract the East 562.79 feet of the West 950.98 feet of the North 420 feet thereof) and except Highways heretofore dedicated

from its present classification as an R-1 (Residence 5 acres) District to an R-2 (Residence 40,000 square feet) District be and hereby is protested by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills. The propsed amendment is inconsistent with the Zoning Ordinance and Village plan heretofore adopted by said Village.
