Jim, here is my comments:

- 1. Don't forget your best deal on generic drugs is Walmart; \$4 for a 30 day supply or \$12 for 90 days. They have a printed list that you can pick up at the pharmacy of all generics they offer the \$4 price on. Get the list and then talk to your doctor about switching from your expensive proprietary drugs to generics. Incidentally the V.A. will charge you \$8 for a 30 day supply. As I often say every \$ counts when your on a fixed income!
- 2. We owe ourselves a pat on the back for unanimously approving and showing our support for the St. Leo Campus for Veterans. A joint program supported by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and Catholic Charities. Our \$'s will provide needy veterans with a home, medical care and a rsource center for job placement and benefits screening. We will be helping to heal and house our fellow veterans with compassion and dignity.
- 3. Another sound program we're working on is our financial support of the new chapel in bldg. 134 of the North Chicago V.A. We will be helping to provide a place of worship for the 180 nursing home veterans who are housed on the 1st and 2nd floor of this bldg. I salute all comrades for your support of this worthwhile project. I am working with Chaplin Bill Vander Hayden on this project, and will keep you informed as we move towards completion.
- 4. The next program I'm looking at for possible support from Post 7706 is the Transitional Living Services program for veterans in Hebron, Ill. I will also keep you posted as I gain more information and incite as to where our \$'s would be best spent.
