Create a Podcast using GarageBand and SoundCloud in 10 Steps



2) Click on the "Audio" icon of a microphone and click "Create." You can also adjust your "input" if you are using a plugged in microphone or headset.





3) Choose "Voice" and "Compressed Voice" to adjust the track.

4) Double click on "Compressed Vocal" track and change title.



If you still need to adjust input and output settings for microphones/headphones, click on GarageBand in the top left \rightarrow preferences \rightarrow choose audio output. Adjust system settings with the drop-down menu.

6) To record, click on the red circle and start speaking. Click on the square to stop. You can click and drag the arrow back to the beginning of the recording and click the triangle play button to listen to your recording. If you want to re-record, you can easily just double click on the area that you recorded and press the delete button on your keyboard.



7) To add another track, click on the + above your original track. You can change the title of this track as well



To add music, click on the "loop" symbol in the top right corner. A list of music options will appear. Click and drag your selected music to the new track that you created.



8) Click and drag the different tracks to adjust music accordingly. You can also adjust volume by clicking on the yellow dots.

9) To download the song, click on "Share" and "Export Song to Disk."
