### Latest Laser Technology by Gary S. Churchill, MD

What medical lasers are now able to do is remarkable. Early lasers were basic units that delivered high-intensity light, accomplishing little more than burning the tissue. But today's lasers are finely tuned to accomplish very specific tasks with minimal side effects.

At The Center for Facial Plastic Surgery, we have four different lasers, each with its own specific purpose. Our two newest lasers, the Lyra-YAG and Orion-KTP, have very useful and unique advances that make them very effective for numerous treatment options

The newest innovation in laser technology is surface cooling. This allows more energy to be delivered to the deeper skin structures while protecting the outer skin from damage. The laser hand-piece consists of a crystal window that is kept cold with a circulating refrigerated coolant. The cold crystal is placed against the skin and light is transmitted through it. This keeps the outer skin surface cool while the laser light creates heat under the surface to remove pigment, blood vessels or hair. The light can also stimulate collagen deposits to tone the skin.

We reviewed the Lyra-YAG laser last month. Now, we will discuss the Orion-KTP laser:

#### Orion-KTP Laser

This laser has an emerald-green colored light. This color is absorbed by both hemoglobin in the blood vessels and abnormal dark pigment deposits in the skin. This laser is more powerful than earlier versions and also incorporates a cooling hand-piece. It is used to treat the follow-

• Rosacea/Broken Capillaries/Red Spots -This laser is ideal for removing red vascular blemishes on the face. The number of treatments depends on the problem. There is generally no down-time, as the blood vessels blanche but do not bruise or show any other signs of being treated.

• Sun Spots/Age Spots—These can be treated on the face or on other parts of the body. There is about a one-week period when the brown spots will become darker as they work their way to the surface before finally peeling off. Typically, only one treatment is necessary. But on occasion, spots need additional fading with repeated laser treatments.

· Skin Toning—This laser is used in conjunction with the Lyra-YAG to stimulate collagen deposits in the skin. Since this laser does not penetrate as deeply, it stimulates collagen at a more superficial level of the dermis and complements the results of the Lyra-YAG.



#### Negotiating a Separation Package— What Should You Consider?

The negotiation of a separation package is often started by the employer when advising you that your position has been eliminated. However, sometimes the employment relationship has deteriorated to the point where the end of the relationship is expected and separation discussions commence. In either situation, knowing what to consider in the negotiation of the separation package can be key to making a successful exit from the company. In particular, you need to consider the realistic value of the separation package. The answer to this question will largely depend on the reason for the separation, your position with the company and length of service. However, another factor that greatly influences the value of the package is whether the employer has committed any violation of state or federal laws during the relationship. Such laws include violations of state and federal discrimination laws, including Title VII, which prevents discrimination based on gender, race, religion or national origin; the Age Discrimination in Employment Act, which protects individuals over 40 years of age from wrongful termination; and the Americans With Disabilities Act, which protects an employee from a permanent disability. Moreover, state laws should also be considered regarding claims for defamation, intentional infliction of emotional distress and violation of public policies.

If you suspect that any of your rights have been violated, your potential damages should be evaluated before the package is negotiated. Also, before the package is finalized, you should consider how the money will be paid, whether in a lump sum or over time. This is especially true if the company is having financial dif- Area Professional Women.



ficulties or if any term of the agreement could prevent further payments, such as violating restrictions regarding future employment. Other considerations include the evaluation and payment of benefits and other forms of compensation. Particularly, you should determine any final pay issues such as vacations, commissions and bonuses. Finally, once you are presented with the proposed separation package, be sure that all terms of the agreement are included. This is especially true if you are required to sign a release which waives any claims. Because this is only a brief discussion of the many considerations involved in the negotiation of a separation agreement, it is highly recommended that you seek the assistance of legal counsel.
