The Treasurer's report was read and approved,

Mr. Prentice reported that ^{of our quota} \$290, ^{\$400.} had been subscribed to the pension fund, and that \$275 had been paid in.

It was reported that of our quota of \$1440 to the Crusade for Christ \$365 had been pledged and over \$700.00 has been paid in on the pledges. Pledges have been received from 55 families.

Sproul reported that back assessments could be liquidated for about \$3000.00 (over)

M. + P. Dentice made a motion that the financial committee be given the power to borrow not more than \$2000.00 to pay on the back assessments.
