

April 5, 1944 - Meeting of the  
Official Board of the Barrington  
Methodist Church was held in the

The meeting was opened with  
prayer by Rev. Doenecke.

The minutes of the previous meeting  
were read and accepted.

The Treasurer's report was read  
and approved.

It was reported that the paid in  
pledges on the ministerial pension  
fund <sup>amounted to</sup> over \$1,700.00.

A second letter soliciting funds  
for the Waldorf Memorial was read,  
and turned over to Rev. Doenecke  
(an individual proposition).

The following nominating committee  
was appointed. Blair Plimpton as  
chairman, Roselle, Dr. Lindberg, and,  
Doetterer, and John Bell.

The nominating committee is to select a  
Sunday School Superintendent.

The disposition of special assessments and interest thereon, which total \$3700<sup>00</sup> was discussed. A motion was made and seconded that we pay the current assessment of \$42.83 and all following assessments as they fall due. A discussion on a union vacation program.

B. Plimpton suggested an exchange of ministers during the vacation period.

B. Plimpton moved that we approve a vacation <sup>program</sup> as set up by the group of ministers - motion carried.

Communion service Thursday April 6, 1945  
a vote of thanks was given to L. Smiley, Roselle & Suter for the Honor Roll <sup>which</sup> they made for the church. Here are 54 names on the Honor Roll.

It was reported that \$990<sup>00</sup> has been paid in the organ fund, 2 1/2 dozen organs are available in the Chicago area ranging in price from 3 to 5 thousand dollars.

Motion made and seconded that a note of thanks be written to Mrs. Doetterer for in appreciation for the fine work she as leader of the choir, the individuals of the choir and the pianist, ~~continue to~~ give <sup>to</sup> the church.
