A motion was made and carried that E. S. Smith be elected lay delegate and W. Dawson alternate delegate.

Motion made and carried that we authorize Mr. H. L. Conner to shingle the south half of the church roof at \$1.65 per man hour.

Mrs. Drower suggested that we start liquidating the Home Missions loan of \$5,000. that there probably are churches that need the use of the money.

She was informed that as soon as the back assessments are liquidated that the Home Missions loans was the next debt on our liquidation program.
