- 1 - We will seek to grow as Christians
- 2 - We will seek to bring others into the Christian fellowship of the Church and of the Woman's Society of Christian Service.
- 3 - We will seek with Christians everywhere the sustaining fellowship and power of a World-wide Christian Church.
- 4 - We will use all available resources to work for "things that belong unto peace."
- 5 - We will proclaim the world mission of the church to be God's plan for the redemption of the world.
- 6 - We will accept the price of Christian discipleship.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Woman's Society of Christian Service shall be to unite all the women of the church in Christian living and service; to help develop and support Christian work among women and children around the world; to develop the spiritual life; to study the needs of the world; to take part in such service activities as will strengthen the local church, improve civic, community, and world conditions. To this end this organization shall seek to enlist women, young people, and children in the Christian fellowship, and to secure funds for the activities in the local church and the support of the work undertaken at home and abroad for the establishment of a world Christian community.

OUR GIVING

The funds of the Society are made up of money voluntarily given by the members through the circles, and by the proceeds of such projects as rummage sales, dinners, and special events undertaken for the purpose of earning money.

Two-thirds of our budget is designated for benevolences. These include the pledge to the Woman's Division of the Rock River Conference, which asks for \$7.12 per capita; financial aid to Rev. and Mrs. Philip Philip in their preparation for Christian work in their native India; gifts at Christmas and at other times to many Methodist supported homes, hospitals, and to institutions at home and abroad.
