



Freegal-Instructions for a Mobile Device

Download the Freegal App

- Go to the Apple App Store or Google Play Store and search for “freegal”
- Download and open the freegal app
- Search for Barrington Area Library
- You will be prompted to log in
 - You do not need to create an account. Simply log in with your library card number

Search

- At the bottom of the screen, use the search function to look for a specific title
- Use the browse function to sort by genre

Download Music

- Preview songs by tapping on three dots and pressing play
- Download up to 5 songs per week & keep them forever (music videos count as 2 credits)
- For future downloading, add songs to a wishlist by tapping ‘add to wishlist’
 - Access your wishlist on the top blue menu bar

Listening

- You can listen through the Freegal app, but please note that if the app is ever deleted you will also lose all your downloads
- To backup your files on from a mobile device, connect your device to a computer and open iTunes. Click the icon of your device on the left side of iTunes. On the left you will see ‘settings’. Select ‘file sharing’ and scroll down and click ‘freegal music’ to initiate the backup process.
