THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF BARRINGTON

INITIAL MEETING OF THE SESSION

The initial meeting of the Session of The Presbyterian Church of Barrington, which was formally organized on Easter Sunday, April 17, 1960, was held at the Manse, 808 Lill Street, Barrington, Illinois, at 8:00 o'clock P.M. on May 2, 1960, pursuant to notice published in the Church Bulletin on Sunday, May 1, 1960, and in conformity with the past practice of holding meetings of the Temporary Council at 8:00 o'clock P.M. on the first Monday of each month.

The meeting was formally opened by the Reverend Paul A. Winchester with a prayer.

The Reverend Paul A. Winchester appointed Charles Board as Clerk of the meeting and announced that the first order of business was the election of a permanent Stated Clerk of the Session.

Wilbur Edwards was duly nominated, seconded and elected Stated Clerk of the Session.

The question of the time at which Sunday Services should be held during the summer months was brought up and discussed at length.

Thereupon, on motion by Gordon Monsen, seconded by Donald Thomas, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Sunday Service and Church School be held at 9:30 o'clock A.M. commencing Sunday, June 4, 1960, and extending through Sunday, September 11, 1960.

The question of authorizing the Pastor to employ a Secretary then came before the meeting and after a

discussion, on motion by Norman Tucker, seconded by William Rose, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Pastor be authorized to employ a Secretary on a part-time basis at a rate of compensation to be determined by him but not to exceed \$2.00 per hour.

The question of when the Charter Membership of the Church should be closed was brought before the Session and discussed at considerable length.

Thereupon, on motion by Gordon Monsen, seconded by Eldred Gough, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Charter Membership List of Members be closed as at the end of Easter Sunday, April 17, 1960.

The next question to come before the Session was the official installation of the Pastor by The Chicago Presbytery and various dates were considered.


Thereupon, on motion by Charles Board, seconded by Henry Beard, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

RESOLVED, that 4:00 o'clock P.M.,
Sunday, May 22, 1960, be fixed as the time
for the installation of the Pastor of the
Church by The Chicago Presbytery.

The Pastor then appointed Eldred Gough and
Donald Thomas as a Committee of Elders to consult
with him and to assist in planning the installation
meeting.

The Reverend Marc Kendall at the invitation
of the Session addressed it in respect of the forth-
coming Every-Member canvass.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:50 o'clock
P.M. with a prayer by the Reverend Marc Kendall.
