The meeting was opened with prayer by the Reverend Harold Johnson at the request of the Pastor, the Reverend Paul A. Winchester.

The Reverend Lester J. Dacken reported that it was the conclusion of the Ministerial Relations Department that the Pastor should move to another Church and that the Pastor was in agreement with this conclusion.

Both the Ministerial Relations Department and the Pastor assured the Session that they would move as fast as possible to locate the Pastor in another Church.

The Ministerial Relations Department recommended that the Session and the Pastor work together as harmoniously as possible until a change can be arranged; that this is in the best interest of the Church, the Pastor and the Session; and that if no progress is made by the end of August, 1963, a further meeting be held to review the situation.

On motion of Charles Boand, seconded by Herbert Smith, it was unanimously resolved that the recommendation of the Ministerial Relations Department be accepted.
