

The Presbyterian Church of Barrington

Meeting of the Congregation
Easter Sunday
April 17, 1960

The first meeting of the Congregation of The Presbyterian Church of Barrington was called to order in the Countryside School Auditorium at 4:52 on the afternoon of Easter Sunday, April 17, 1960, by Rev. S. Charles Shangler.

Mr. Jack Train was appointed clerk and instructed to record the proceedings of the meeting.

There was present at the meeting the following Commission which had been designated by The Presbytery of Chicago to organize The Presbyterian Church of Barrington:

Mr. John R. Bartizal, President of the Church Extension Board of The Presbytery of Chicago,

Dr. Paul Stumpf, Pastor of The First Presbyterian Church of Arlington Heights, Illinois, and

The Rev. S. Charles Shangler, Director of Extension Churches, Church Extension Board of The Presbytery of Chicago.

Dr. William T. Jones presided at the meeting.

After a greeting by Mr. John Gerber, President of Barrington Ministerial Union, Mr. Henry Beard, as chairman of the Nominating Committee, moved that the following men be selected as Elders of the Church by acclamation:

The motion was duly seconded and appropriately carried.

The newly elected Elders were assembled in front of the Congregation where they were ordained and installed. Mr. Wilbur Edwards and Mr. Hal Wilson, having already been ordained as Elders of other Congregations, assisted Rev. Shangler in this ceremony. The Prayer of Ordination was given by Dr. Paul Stumpf.

Mr. Henry Beard reported the Nominating Committee's recommendation that the following men be appointed as Trustees:

Mr. Wilbur Edwards moved that these men be approved as Trustees. The motion was duly seconded and appropriately carried.

Dr. William T. Jones declared the Congregation Duly Organized as a Church in The Presbytery of Chicago.

Mr. Wilbur Edwards nominated Rev. Paul A. Winchester as Pastor of The Presbyterian Church of Barrington with a brief but well chosen description of Rev. Winchester's qualifications and experience. There being no further nominations, it was moved that the Congregation concur with the nomination and elect Rev. Paul A. Winchester as Pastor. The motion was duly seconded and appropriately carried.

Dr. Herbert Brockway gave the prayer for the newly organized Church.

The Sermon was given by the Rev. Simon C. Jepson.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:17 p.m. with the singing of the Hymn, "The Church's One Foundation," and the Benediction.
