GOAL FOR 1914 IN 200 AND 300. PETROLEUM AND GAS WILL BE EXTINCT IN 30 YEARS.

United States Geologist Figure on Nature's Resources and Depleting Reserves. Washington—While there will be 30 years for fuel in the United States 30 years from today the people who live in it will have used up all the coal and silver with which to buy everything they need.
This information is given in a report of the United States geological survey.
