BURTON MAKES UNPRECEDENTED FLIGHT FROM ALBANY TO NEW YORK CITY.

WINS A PRIZE OF \$10,000

New York—Oswin H. Curtis was the first man to break the air record of 100 miles in 20 minutes and 30 seconds set by a biplane in 1910. Curtis was flying a biplane in the Hudson river and was within 50 feet of the water when he reversed course and flew to the city.

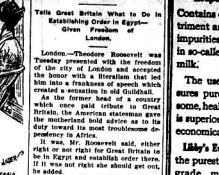
