

CAREER OF EDWARD VII KING OF GREAT BRITAIN

London.—Edward VII, king of the Great Britain, died at 11.10 on Friday night, the 6th inst., at Windsor, assuming the title of George V, and took his death before the very close of Saturday afternoon. Coming so suddenly, the death of the aged monarch brought great sorrow to the nation, and the hearts of Edward, prince of Wales and afterwards as Edward VII, a short reign of nine years has been a history of stirring events. It opened with the coronation of peace after a long and trying campaign, and closed with the conclusion at the critical moment of one of the most important international conferences of our times between the powers and countries of the world.

Death Due to Pneumonia.
Obedient around the bedside of the dying king was the queen and princess. No hope had been held out

that the king would recover. The first official act of the following branches, contracted shortly after his return to Marlborough House. Only a day or two ago the king had been compelled to receive and give audience, but on Wednesday he was obliged to receive the orders of his physicians.
