 Springfield, Ill., Nov. 15. The state  
 tax rate for 1910 was fixed at 30 cents  
 per year by the state tax commission,  
 consisting of Gov. Deussen, Auditor  
 McCullough and Treasurer McCullough.  
 Twenty per cent for revenue and 10  
 cents for school purposes. Under the  
 present law 20 cents is equal to 20 cents  
 under the former law, when assessed  
 values were 50 cents instead of one-  
 third of the actual value.
