DAIRY

BOTTLE IS NON-REFILLABLE

Invention is Designed to Prevent Refilling of Vessel After It Has Once Been Filled.

In describing a non-refillable bottle designed by W. W. Clark of Panama, the Scientific American says:

In this invention the design is to prevent the refilling of the vessel after the original contents have been exhausted. The purpose of the improve-



ment is to provide novel features of construction for a device which will positively seal the bottle against applied pressure in case an attempt is made to refill the same by use of a force pump. The bottle is designed to receive and hold liquid of any density. The illustration herewith represents a longitudinal sectional view showing the bottle simplified and parts adapted to seal the inlet to the bottle against the introduction of liquid.

HOLSTEIN COW GIVES MOST

For Cheese Milk Production. This Breed Surpasses It is Not a Risk in Butter Fat.

On a Holstein cow produce a quart of milk cheaper than a cow of any other breed? It can. But how? A Holstein cow is a big beast, weighing from 1,200 to 1,400 pounds. It has a large capacity for food. The natural fitness to eat enormous quantities of food makes a large production of milk. A cow is a factory for the production of milk. Like any other factory, the larger the amount of product turned out, the cheaper it is produced.

A Holstein cow may be likened to the larger factory. The expense of keeping a cow before a pound of milk is produced isn't much more for a large cow than a small one.

This ability to turn out large quantities of milk belongs to a Holstein, and it is due to their size and capacity for food resulting from their size. While a quart of Holstein milk is produced cheaper than the same quantity of milk produced by any other breed, it isn't as rich in butter fat. Holstein milk averages three per cent or a little more. The other dairy breeds average higher than this, but don't give as much milk.

Incomplete Milking Bad. Incomplete milking not only robs the dairymen of the richest portion of the milk, the scum, but it damages the cow, leading to lessen her daily production and to shorten the period of lactation. It takes a little more time to draw the last pint of milk from the udder, but the time is well spent in view of the gain both to the cow and to the owner.

Autumn Calves. According to some experiments made in Ireland, calves born in the autumn made faster gains during the winter when housed at night in a well-ventilated shed than did calves which were born in the summer. There was a little difference in the two lots. The weather had a more injurious effect on the suggested calves than did a protracted cold spell.

Good and Poor Cows. The practice of getting rid of the poorest cows and putting good ones in their stead looks very expensive, but it is not so expensive as keeping them in the herd to crowd down the profits of the better ones.

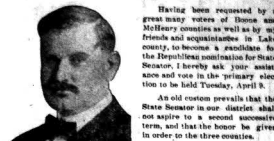
