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# FOES TRANSPORT

IS SUNK BY MINE

Vessel Loaded With Troops and Munitions Destroyed at Vorland

Stockholm Dispatch Says That Another German Ship Carrying Soldiers and Munitions Sunk at the Island

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# NEW LIBERTY

LOAN 3 BILLION

McAdoo Makes Announcement of Third Issue of War Bonds.

Campaign Opens on April 1—Secretary of the Treasury to Oversee Securities to Issue

Washington, March 27.—Secretary McAdoo announced today that the amount of the new Liberty loan would be \$3,000,000,000, the highest rate 4 1/2 per cent interest and all subscriptions will be accepted.

The secretary of the treasury plans this following a conference with Representative Vreeland, chairman of the ways and means committee of the house, and will ask congress for approval.

Outstanding features of the third war loan are as follows: The bonds will be nonconvertible, but bonds of the first and second war loans may be converted into the new 4 1/2 per cent securities.

The bonds will be payable at par and interest in gold or in government securities at the option of the holder.

They will have the benefit of a sinking fund of 5 per cent per annum during the period of the war and one year thereafter.

Authority to issue \$2,500,000,000 in bonds in addition to the \$3,000,000,000 already authorized and unpaid to the treasury is also included in the bill.
