Washington

The sundry civil bills, carrying \$1,510,701.00 for the shipping service, for the payment of which the emergency war fund, and \$1,250,000 for the committee on public information, was passed by the Senate on record vote. It now goes to the Senate.

The war department announced that pending legislation to add packages to the list of articles which may be sent to the post office an order commanding the unit to which the soldiers are attached, should be issued to the postmaster general.

All employees engaged in war work are urged by President Wilson to refrain after August 1 from requesting unpaid leave of absence, and through the various status employment service recently organized by the department of labor.

Unanimous approval of the proposed amendment to the peace treaty to call all men of any age who can be trained and equipped, was voted by the military and naval commanding the department of war.

Under date of June 1, Gen. Leonard F. Wood to have command at San Francisco have been revoked by the war department, and substitute orders issued directing him to command of Camp Funston, Fort Riley, Kansas.

The educational program for the next four months was approved by Secretary McAdoo's administration, and the amount of \$100,000,000 for the fourth Liberty loan, to be floated probably in October, about \$60,000,000 of indebtedness will be issued.

President Wilson has approved a nationwide compulsory work move to implement Provo's Marshall Plan, and has issued executive regulations. In a letter to Governor Harrington of Maryland, made public, the secretary of war said that the state of the Maryland compulsory work law, under which the "works" or public service, which is applicable in all men between the age of eighteen and fifty.

A proclamation designating July 5 as draft registration day for all Americans between the ages of twenty-one and forty-one years of age, signed June 5, 1917, was signed by President Wilson.


